Inpatient Surgery



- Hospital Stay
 - After your surgery, you will come out to the recovery room.
 - Your nurse will monitor your vital signs, incision site, pain and overall comfort
 - Once you have begun to wake up from anesthesia and are comfortable, you will be transitioned out to a room in the hospital

Inpatient Surgery



- Hospital Stay
 - The nursing care team will be continually checking your vital signs, pain and comfort
 - The nursing staff will get you out of bed and to the bathroom when you are ready
 - You will see physical therapy the following morning





Pain

- Make sure that you let your nurse know when you start having pain
- The goal is to keep your pain at a 5/10 or below
