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► Medications

- STOP taking 7 days before scheduled surgery
 - Advil
 - Alleve
 - Ibuprofen
 - Motrin
 - Vitamins
 - Herbs



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- If you are on a blood thinner, your physician will give you special instructions for stopping the medications before surgery
- Your medications will be reviewed at your pre-op appointment at the hospital and what you are still able to take and what you can't
- Mobic/Meloxicam and Celebrex can be continued up to day of surgery



Medications

► Post-operation Medication

- Someone from the Orthopedic office should be calling your pharmacy for your post-op medications
- They should be at your pharmacy 5 days prior to surgery
- Make sure that you call your pharmacy to check if you don't hear anything from your pharmacy
